

## **Grant Application Reconsideration**

Each quarter, grant applications are reviewed, discussed and evaluated by the 16- member board of directors.

The Black Hawk County Gaming Association receives many more applications than its resources will permit it to fund. This leads to difficult decisions in establishing priorities and means that, during each quarterly grant application review, a number of applications are eliminated. The board may also vote to delay until a subsequent quarter the final decision on an application.

If a grant application is eliminated at the initial screening meeting (usually, the first meeting following the application deadline), a board member may request the Board President to propose its reconsideration at the next meeting. The board will decide whether to reconsider the application. Following reconsideration of an application, the board may vote either not to fund it or to keep it in the group of applications being considered for funding, ranking it last among them.

If the board votes, at a funding meeting, to deny funding to an application, it will not be eligible for reconsideration at a future meeting. A new application for the same project may be submitted for consideration in a subsequent quarter.
