Isle Casino Hotel Waterloo opened June 30, 2007 and has paid millions of dollars annually in state, county and local taxes, purchased more than \$149 million of products and services from Iowa-based business through the *Buy Iowa First Program* and paid over \$198 million in payroll, taxes and benefits.

Black Hawk County Gaming Association, the non-profit license holder receives 5.75% of the Adjusted Gross revenue from the Isle. Over the past thirteen years, funds have been used to enhance the Cedar Valley and make it a stronger, better place to live!
